Reading: Our next story is A Froggy Fable. In this story students will be asked to draw conclusions from a text as well as work on final syllable -le. Each student can access the reading textbook online to read the stories. I will assign other activities as well for extra practice. When your child logs in, the orange box in the middle is where the assignments I have posted are located. All the assignments will be posted there as well as the math. Let me know if you need assistance. They are not for a grade.

Saxon Phonics: We will work on lessons 71 to 75. Lesson 71 and 72 are working with trigraphs, lesson 73 is working with suffixes, lesson 74 is sight words, and lesson 75 is an assessment.

Envision Math 2.0: In math we are subtracting within 100 using different strategies. We will work on lessons 5-1 to 5-3. Lesson 5-1 is subtracting tens and ones on a hundred chart. Lesson 5-2 and 5-3 is subtracting on an open number line.

English: We are continuing the writing process. Students are drafting, revising, and editing their two point expository paragraph.

Social Studies: We will identify signs of citizen pride as well as read a picture graph.

Science: We will review rocks and minerals for our **test on Friday**. A study guide will be in their Science binders.

Writing: During morning work and extra time, our class practices daily handwriting skills. We will begin cursive! ☺
