Wednesday: Fact assessment

Friday: Reading test, Spelling test, and Saxon Phonics test

Reading: Our next story is Soil. We will review diphthongs as well as fact and opinion. Each student can access the reading textbook online to read the stories. I will assign other activities as well for extra practice. When your child logs in, the orange box in the middle is where the assignments I have posted are located. All the assignments will be posted there; as well as the math. Let me know if you need assistance. They are not for a grade.

Saxon Phonics: We will work on lessons 81 to 85. Lesson 81 is syllable division, lesson 82 is suffixes -ful and -ness, lesson 83 is final stable syllable -tion, lesson 84 is sight words, and lesson 85 is an assessment.

Envision Math 2.0: In math we are subtracting within 100 using different strategies. We will work on lessons 5-6, 5-8, and 5-9. Lesson 5-6 is continuing to break apart numbers to subtract, lesson 5-8 is solve one-step and two-step problems, and lesson 5-9 is critique reasoning.

English: We will continue to work on subject-verb agreement and pronouns. **Your child needs to know the word earnest. The definition of earnest means not joking; serious. The synonym for the word is sincere and the antonym for the word is unconcerned.**

Social Studies: We will identify characteristics of good citizenship and identify ordinary people who exemplify good citizenship.

Science: In Science we will identify gravity as a force as well as observe and describe the effect of friction on the movement of objects.

Writing: During morning work and extra time, our class practices daily handwriting skills. We are continuing to write in cursive.
