**Reading:** Our next reading story is, Bad Dog, Dodger. Our reading concepts this week are working with consonant patterns as well as reviewing plot/theme. Don't forget to log into the Pearson Realize website for extra practice.

**Saxon Phonics:** We will work on lessons 101 to 105. Lesson 101 is working with final stable syllable -sion, lesson 102 is digraph ew, lesson 103 is the doubling rule, lesson 104 is sight words, and lesson 105 is an assessment.

**Envision Math 2.0:** We will review for a test on Thursday. Study topic 6 in class/homework sheets as well as on the Pearson Realize website.

**English:** We will publish our papers. We will also learn about possessive pronouns, exclamatory sentences, finding two prepositional phrases in a sentence, and choosing either "a" or "an" to complete a sentence. **For this chapter your child needs to know the word patient. The definition of the word means not getting upset when troubled. The synonym for the word is calm and the antonym for the word is anxious.**

**Social Studies:** We will compare maps and globes. We will also use a globe to find the poles, the cardinal directions, and the equator.

**Science:** We will review for a test on Thursday. Each student will be taking home their science binder to study from.

**Writing:** During morning work and extra time, our class practices daily handwriting skills. We are continuing to practice writing in cursive.
